By the Numbers: Trial Start Up Status

- A total of 138 sites (121 in USA and 17 in Canada) are participating in SATURN.
- A total of **119 Clinical Trial Agreements have been issued** as of January 17, 2020.
- 47 CTAs have been fully executed.
- A total of **24 US sites have obtained cIRB approval**; **31** are in process.
- A No Objection Letter was issued by Health Canada on December 23, 2019.
- 2 Canadian sites have already obtained local ethics approval.

Helpful Tips to *Expedite* Your Start-Up

- Complete and return Form 3B. We can't send out your CTA until Form3B has been received by the NCC. For Canadian sites, Form W-8BEN will be requested, and sites' overseeing entity must be registered on SAM.gov to receive payment.
- Check the start-up e-mail from the NCC regulatory specialists for the documents that will be required for cIRB submission (for US sites) and CTA processing.
- Let your contract office know that the CTA is *non-negotiable*.
- For US sites, the study will **not** go through a full board review at your institution. Your institution has already signed a cIRB reliance agreement to cede to the cIRB as the IRB of record. Let us know if you are having any issues with local requirements. Regulatory Specialists at the NCC can help you. (Please include *Study Name* and *Site Name* in the subject heading of your e-mail).
- Upload Site and People documents and Delegation of Authority Log into WebDCU as soon as possible. You do not need to wait for CTA/cIRB approval to start this.
