Protocol Update: NO Loading Dose Required if.....

1. Subjects who have been on clopidogrel or ticagrelor for at least 5 consecutive days prior to randomization

OR

2. Received a ≥ 300 mg loading dose of clopidogrel or a ≥ 180 mg loading dose of ticagrelor within 5 days before randomization followed by daily clopidogrel or ticagrelor

- Will not receive the loading dose of study antithrombotic medication on day of randomization.
- Instead, they will start the maintenance dose of the study antithrombotic medication on the day they are randomized.

Protocol v3.0 is now approved

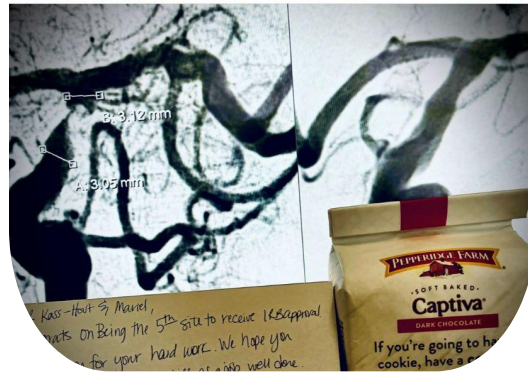
