






Enrollment Updates

Enrollment Status by Site







Tips and Tricks: Ensuring Successful Enrollment and Randomization

- Confirming whether a hemorrhage in proximity to the ventricles is lobar or non-lobar can sometimes be confusing. The key element is to determine whether the hemorrhage seems to originate from the thalamus, putamen, globus pallidus, caudate or internal capsule. If it does, then this is not a lobar ICH. If uncertain or in doubt about ICH proximity to the ventricle or its origin, please feel free to send us an anonymized image depicting the location of the hemorrhage (mselim@bidmc.harvard.edu), we will have the images reviewed by our Imaging Adjudicator and will let you know if this meets the eligibility criteria for enrollment.
- Please make sure that a member of the study team discusses the trial with the subject's provider(s) prescribing statin before enrollment. This provides an opportunity to educate providers about the purpose and nature of SATURN, and ensures that the provider agrees with the subject's randomization and the possibility that statin may be discontinued. This is important to minimize the chances of crossover because a providers feels strongly that his/her natient should continue statin. **Feel free to**

- Remind the potential subjects/LARs and their physicians that while SATURN may prohibit the use of statin, the use of non-statin lipid-lowering agents such as ezetimibe and/or omega-3 fatty acids is permitted if felt necessary.
- It is important that the study team communicates the results of the randomization assignment (i.e. continue/restart vs. discontinue statin) to the treating team and to make sure that the medication orders reflect the actual randomization assignment. Please check the discharge summary and instructions to make sure that they accurately reflect the randomization assignment.
- Remember to send the follow-up letter to the subject's providers to let them know that the subject is enrolled in SATURN and to inform them of the randomization assignment.

Authorization for Release of Medical Records

Please make sure the subject or LAR signs the medical release at the time of consent. This is referenced in the consent form and **important in order to obtain needed medical records in case of adverse event or death.**

By signing this consent document, you are allowing the investigators at BIDMC to contact your doctors. In some cases, we may request medical information or records about you from your doctor(s) or hospital(s) in which you receive future treatment.

For this reason, we ask you to sign an authorization for release of medical record/information form (attached) to allow your doctors and medical facilities to release your records to the investigators at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston (if needed). Again, the investigators at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center are obliged to protect your privacy and confidentiality.
