This document reviews how to use WebDCU. It is a useful tool if you need to do the following:

- Obtain a user account
- Add/edit study team members on the DOA
- Submit Regulatory Documents
- Find project documents
- Enter data for a subject
- Respond to queries

Adding/Editing Study Team Members on Electronic DOA Log

- From the study's main menu page, click on [User Management], and then |
- Click on the blue number link to the left of your site name.
- Click [Edit Record] in the upper right-hand corner.
 - **To add a site team member to the DOA log**, select their name from the drop down box under section 6: Team Member Request and enter the study. Select the study team member's role(s) by selecting the appropriate key. Please refer to the Study Role key at the bottom of the page. Next, select the DOA responsibilities assigned to this study team member key at the bottom of the page.
 - **To remove a site team member from the DOA log**, enter an end date under section 5: Active Team Members.
 - **To change the roles and/or responsibilities of a current site team member**, first need to enter an end date for their current roles and responsibilities.

Just a reminder that we are still using Tess for all randomized subjects. In order to make Tess more user friendly, we created a Qualtrics link, https://umich.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_b73MvftChJgdfAa. Now instead of having a participant text Tess for the first time, the subject's information can be entered using this link. All that is needed is subject ID, randomization assignment, and cell number!

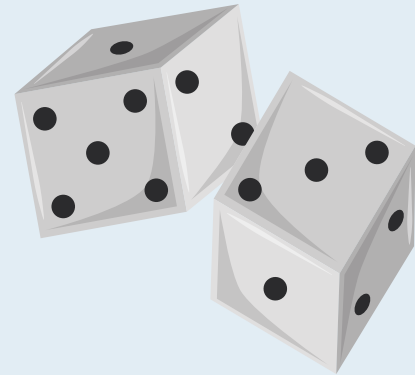
Recruitment, reconsidered

A patient who meets inclusion criteria and does not have obvious exclusion criteria still seems ... “too old”, “too frail”, “too unhappy”, “too busy”, “too incapacitated”, “too xxx” ... to be a good candidate for Sleep SMART. Should we still spend time explaining the study to assess interest?

YES – please remain open to doing so. Entry criteria for Sleep SMART were deliberately fashioned to cast a broad net. Please consider recruitment of patients who meet criteria; you generally don't need to apply further filters except where implied in the protocol or MOP.

My subject meets randomization criteria, but should they be randomized?

You must ask them! The patient has to be willing to accept a 50% chance of CPAP for 6 months and a 50% chance of no CPAP for 6 months.
