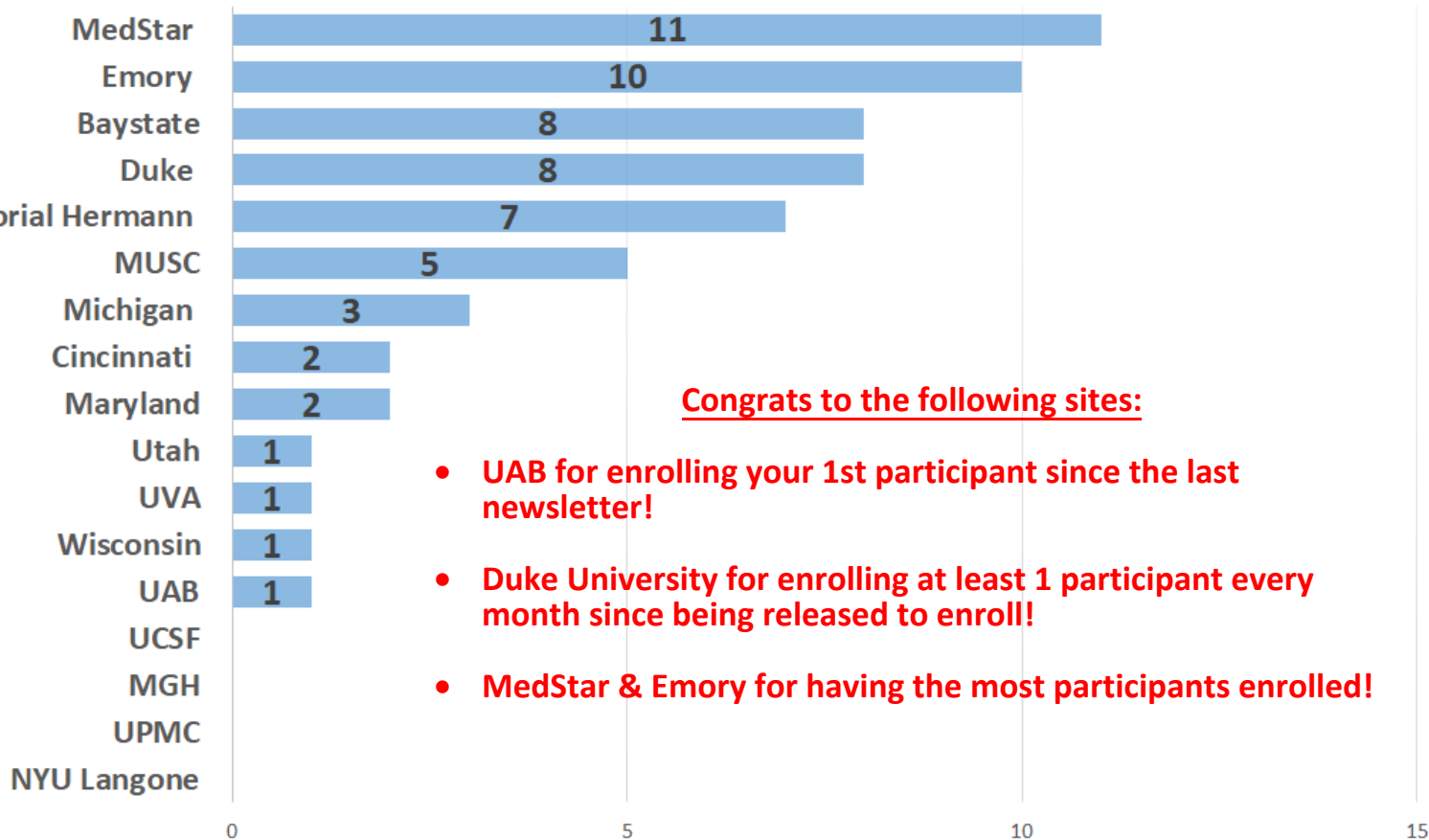


## Study Reminders

- Protocol amendment v1.6 has been cIRB approved.
  - The updated virtual protocol training slides v1.6 is available on the DCU campus training website: <https://dcu.musc.edu/campus/>
    - Please ensure your study team reviews the updated protocol. Sites should document protocol trainings for study staff onsite in your regulatory binder.
- Study book/source documentation packet v6.0 is available in the toolbox tab of WebDCU.
- The updated pocketcards v3.0 are available in the toolbox tab of WebDCU. Sites can print these pocket cards and keep them on their TMS carts as a quick reminder of important study-specific information.

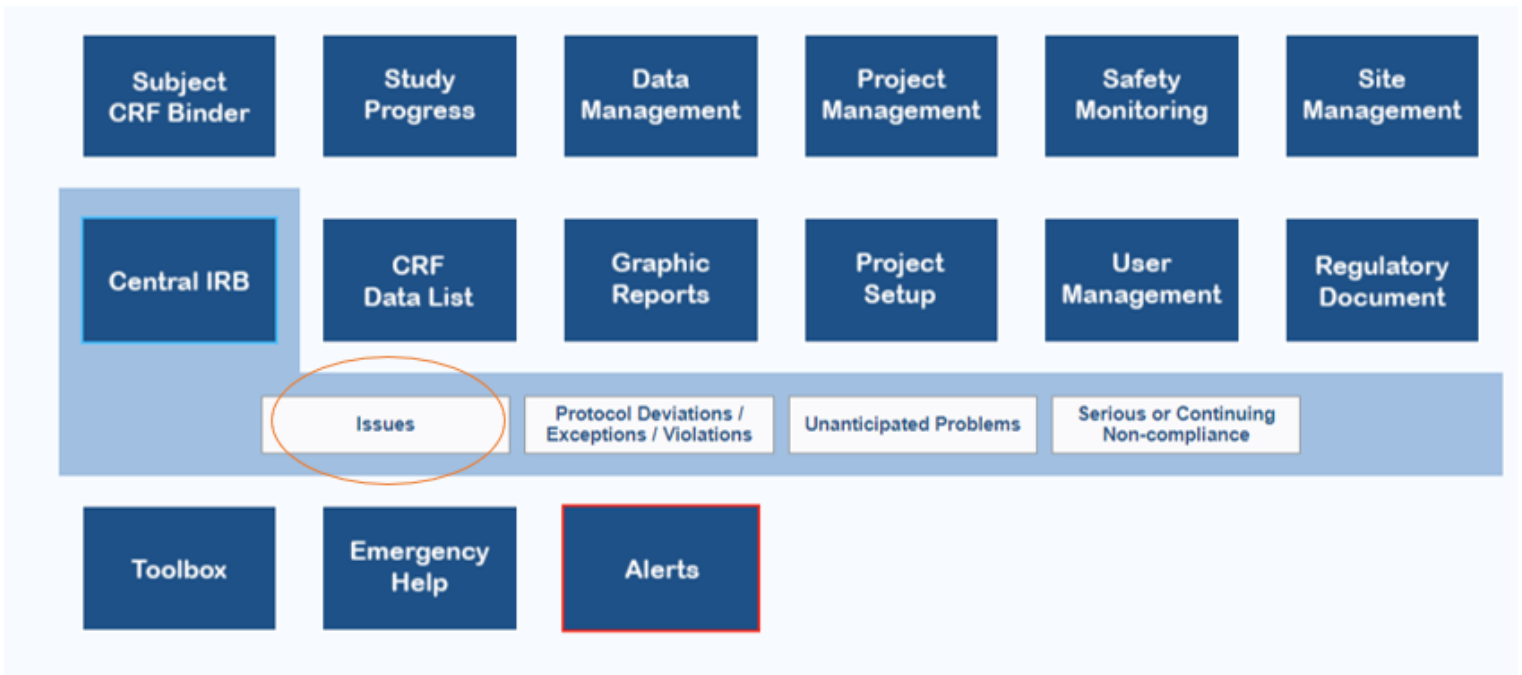

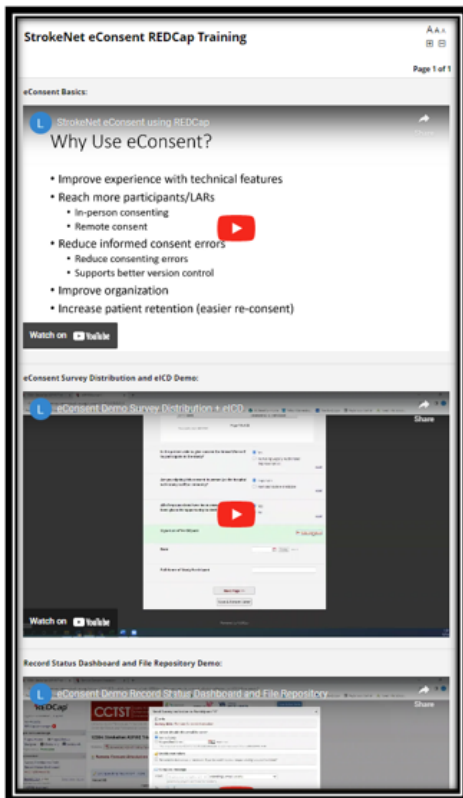

# RedCap eConsent Training



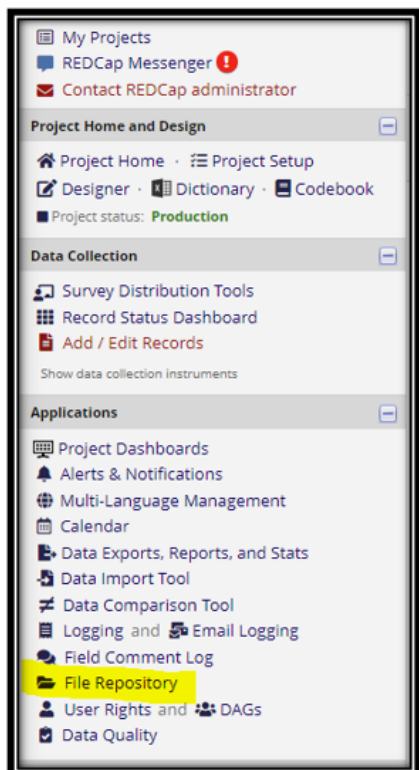
## Who should complete RedCap eConsent training?

- All sites using REDCap eConsent should ensure that all consenters have completed the following eConsent training:

- VERIFY specific REDCap eConsent guide is available in the toolbox tab of WebDCU.

## How should sites document RedCap eConsent Training for audit purposes?

- Completion of training certificate should be kept in your site's regulatory binder onsite.

## Correct Method for Downloading eConsents

- Completed consents should be accessed through the “**File Repository**” in REDCap.
  - Do NOT access completed consents from the “Record Status Dashboard”
    - This runs risk of having incorrect consents being printed (e.g., wrong version and/or date)

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- The VERIFY leadership team strongly prefer that FM & ARAT are performed by PT/OT/MD; any exceptions require explicit prior approval from the VERIFY Study PIs.
- These assessments are complex and require experience.
- Since these assessments are the primary outcome measures, the VERIFY leadership team will only accept exceptions to staff who are not PT/OT/MD based on strong justification including prior experience performing these assessments.
